FACILITIES

The Pool

The centrepiece of the BEST Centre is our outdoor Olympic-sized training pool. The 10 lane, 50m pool ($50m \times 25m \times 2m$) is a free-standing pool from Astra, who supply the competition pools for the FINA world championships.

Es Trenc and Es Estanys

Are the beaches on the west side of the town. Es Estanys is the area of beach closest to the town, and then Es Trenc stretches for 3000m of natural beauty. It is one of the few areas on the island to find sand dunes. In 1984 Es Trenc was declared a "Special Interest Natural Area".

There are bars at either end of the beach and sunbeds and umbrellas are available, although in limited numbers. There is a beach cafe and facilities on *Es Estanys*.

Es Dolç and Es Carbó

Are the beaches on the east of the town. Es Dol_{ζ} is the area of beach closer to the port with Es Carbo a little further round the headland.

While Es Trenc is the most famous of the island's beaches, Es Carbó and Ses Roquetes are preferred by those in the know. A 20 minute walk from Es Dolç will bring you to 1300m of virgin, 'S' shaped beach. If you don't fancy the walk, there are boats to hire to take you to the beaches. There are no beach cafes here, just sand and solitude.



LOCATION

The BEST Centre is located in the south-east corner of Mallorca, in one of the islands most beautiful towns: Colònia Sant Jordi. It boasts some of the best beaches in Europe. It is a great place for strolling, cycling, fishing and kayaking, as well as numerous other outdoor activities. We will include plenty of fun activities away from the pool to make this a really memorable holiday.

Colònia Sant Jordi is where the locals and those in the know take their holidays and weekends away. The small town of Colònia Sant Jordi, nestling in the south east corner of the island in the municipality of Ses Salinas, is renowned for its golden sand, crystal water and peaceful setting. Surrounded entirely by national park the town opens out onto some of the best beaches in the mediterranean. This is an amazing location to be!

Colònia Sant Jordi has everything you need to make your camp a success. The town is neither too large nor too small, and a short walk from the training centre you will find plenty of cafes, bars and restaurants, among them, according to the national press, the best paella not just on the island but in all of Spain!

BEACHES

The stunning beaches on this part of the island have made Colònia Sant Jordi the most famous destination in the Balearic Islands. *Es Trenc*, on the west side of the town is the most well known of all the beaches in Mallorca because of its miles of golden sand, crystal clear water and

national parkland behind. The beach of *Es Trenc*, the coastal area around Colònia Sant Jordi and the island of *Cabrera*, renowned for its marine tourism, form what has been called the 'magical triangle' of the Balearics, because of its beauty and tranquility.





GETTING HERE

Transfers to and from the airport/hotel are not included in the price. However, the BEST Centre, out of the kindness of its heart, will organise a limited number of bus transfers on the FAMILY TRIATHLON HOLIDAY ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE DAY (Please note, these are the dates of the Family Triathlon Holiday not necessarily your holiday dates if you are arriving days earlier or staying days later). The times of these buses will be forwarded to everyone attending the camp roughly 2 weeks in advance of arrival.

Please note that while we will do our best to organise the transfers to benefit as many families as we can, we can't do transfers for everyone. If your arrival time does not coincide with our free transfers, we are happy to book a transfer for you at an extra cost.

If booking a transfer through us, the prices are as follows:

- 1-4 people 60 euros one-way.
- 5-7 people 110 euros one-way.
- If you are a family of 8 or more people, please contact us for the price of a transfer.

There is also the option of car hire at the airport. Here are directions to get to the BEST Centre if you chose this option:

- 1. Exit the airport following signs to Playa de Palma. This will take you over the motorway and loop you round so you are heading east on the Ma-19 towards Llucmajor.
- 2. As you approach Llucmajor, stay on the Ma-19 and follow the signs to Campos.
- 3. As you enter Campos you will pick up signs to Colònia Sant Jordi and you will veer towards the right, past an Eroski supermarket (which is on your left) and around the south side of Campos, following signs to Colònia Sant Jordi.
- 4. The signs will take you to a petrol station as you enter Colònia Sant Jordi. Keep going straight on, passing the petrol station on your left, until you reach the hotel Isla Cabrera after 100 m or so. Take the right hand turn after the hotel, Calle de Roada and this will take you to the BEST Centre.

We have plenty of kick boards and pull buoys so there is no need to bring them. Bring your goggles (we have a range of mirrored and tinted goggles for sale at the pool), swimsuits, caps and plenty of waterproof, high protection sunscreen at FACTOR 50.

ADITIONAL INFORMATION

DISCOUNTS: If you are a family of 5 or more people, the first four people pay the usual price, and each person after that receives a 5% discount off the lowest priced person in the family, i.e. a family of 5 will receive a 5 percent discount off a non-triathlete child or an adult. (Note: A non triathlete child is aged 16 or under).

1-2-1s: During the holiday we can organise 1-2-1 sessions of 30 or 60 minutes with individual triathlets. As time is very limited during the week, it is best to book these in advance to avoid disappointment. Please note we do not offer 1:2:1 sessions on the arrival or departure days of our holiday dates. Cost for 30 minute session is 35 euros and 60 minutes is 50 euros. Exact times of 1-2-1s will be confirmed upon arrival. Please email Pamela (pamela@bestswimcentre.com) to book a 1-2-1.

CANCELLATIONS: Any cancellations up to March 6th 2020 will incur a 30 percent loss of deposit. Cancellations after April 6th 2020 will incur a 100 percent loss of deposit.



TOURIST TAX

As you may already know, the Balearic Parliament has recently passed Law 2/2016 on the Taxation of Tourist Accommodation on the Balearic Islands, which started 1st July 2016. This tax will be applied to anyone staying in a tourist accommodation located on the Balearic Islands.

The tax will range between 50 cents and 2 Euros per person per day/part of a day, plus 10% VAT, depending on the type and category of accommodation, as listed below:

Types of tourist accommodation	€ / day or part of a day (*plus 10% VAT)
5-star, 5-star luxury and 4-star superior hotels, city hotels and aparthotels	€2
4-star and 3-star superior hotels, city hotels and aparthotels	€ 1.50
1, 2 and 3-star hotels, city hotels and aparthotels	€1
4-key and 4-key superior tourist apartments	€2
3-key superior tourist apartments	€ 1.50
1, 2 and 3-key tourist apartments	€1
Non-residential accommodation establishments of tourism-residential companies	€2
Tourist holiday homes and homes subject to tourist stay marketing	€1
Rural hotels, agrotourisms and interior tourism accommodation	€1
Hostels, pensions, inns and camping sites	€ 0.50
Lodges and refuges	€ 0.50
Any other establishment of a "tourist character"	€1
Tourist cruise ships	€1

During low season (between 1st November and 30th April of the following year) the tax will be discounted by 50%. In addition, after nine days of any stay, the rate will also be cut by 50%. Children under the age of 16 are exempt from paying the tax.

Therefore, any natural person (over the age of 16) staying in a tourist accommodation on the Balearic Islands is obliged to pay the before mentioned tax to the owner of the establishment where he/she is staying.

As a mediator, you bear the subsidiary responsibility for paying the tax and, consequently, you are entitled to act as a representative of taxpayers in that respect. Therefore, we suggest that you read article 7 of Law 2/2016 on the Taxation of Tourist Accommodation on the Balearic Islands, a copy of which is enclosed herewith.

Furthermore, considering the large amount of questions that you might have regarding the new tourist tax on the Balearic Islands, we hereby provide you with the contact details of the Balearic Tax Agency: 901 201 530 / www.atib.es


ZACHARIAS ALEXIOU

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

BEST SWIM CENTRE

- 1. What age and standard do my children have to be for the Family Triathlon Holidays? We cater for triathletes from ages 12-18 on the family triathlon holidays, but we have some flexibility if your child is a little older or younger than this age range.
- **2.** What type of traithlon will my children be doing? We focus on a lot of technique and drills that young triathletes are sometimes missing from their club environments. There will be plenty of time to focus also on individual needs as well as challenging sets.
- **3.** Who will be coaching my children? Your coach will be former international Triathlete Pamela Geijo, who is the BEST Centre triathlon coach and who runs all our triathlon activity.
- **4. Do they have to train every session?** The training sessions are not obligatory, however we do find that most triathletes come to all sessions because they so much fun!
- **5.** How are the groups of triathletes organized? We primarily organize groups by age and then after the first 1 or 2 sessions organize the groups by standard and needs.
- **6. What is the Triathlete to coach ratio?** This depends on the number of athletes in the group, but the ratio is typically 1 coach for 10-12 triathletes.
- **7.** Can my child get a private 1-2-1 session? Depending on time constraints, it is possible for triathletes to have 1-2-1 sessions with our coaches at an additional cost. These can be organized on-site.
- **8.** What equipment do they need to bring? Please read the general information page of the Family Triathlon Holiday section for a list of equipment needed. We have kickboards and pullbuoys; they will need fins and a snorkel, which we sell onsite or in advance for those who don't have their own.

- **9. What other activities will my children do?** We have football, beach games, table tennis tournaments and the world famous BEST Centre biathlon as well as things like the 100s challenge set, the last day relays and the almost world famous Med Ball throw!
- **10. What activities are there for parents?** We have parents' football, parents' table tennis and a few days to get fit for the parents' relay and parents' biathlon!
- **11.** Can parents swim or use the gym during the sessions? We always leave at least 1 lane free for parents to swim during the sessions (and get fit for the biathlon!). Parents can also use the gym free of charge.
- **12.** Can parents get coached in swimming or take swim lessons? Yes, but it may not always be possible during the same time as the children's training sessions. Please email us for prices and options.
- **13. What's the weather like in Mallorca during the triathlon holidays?** The weather is typically hot!
- **14. Will we have time as a family on our own?** Yes, there is time when we are not training or doing other activities that can be spent as a family.
- 15. Will my kids have fun? We guarantee it!
- 16. How far is the BEST Centre from the airport and how do I get to my hotel?

The BEST Centre is 35 minutes from the airport. Transfers to and from the airport are NOT included in the holiday prices. However, we arrange 3 free coach transfers on the arrival and departure days to help. The times of each transfer are arranged to best suit the most number of people possible. If the time of the transfer is not convenient for you or you arrive or leave on a different day than the arrival and departure day, then you can get to your hotel by taxi or bus, or we can arrange a transfer for you. For "getting here" information please see our website.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **17.** How far is the pool from the hotels? All the hotels we offer are within a 7 minutes walk of the pool.
- **18.** What else is there to do in Colònia Sant Jordi? If you like beaches then you are spoilt for choice as the town is surrounded by some of the most beautiful beaches in the Med. We are only a few kilometres boat ride from the natural protected marine park island of Cabrera, while the sea around the town is home to numerous water sports. You can also hire road bikes and mountain bikes, take tennis lessons, use the spa if you stay at the Club Colònia Blau hotel, or rent a car and explore a little more of the island.
- **19.** Are there any excursions included on the holiday? We offer excursions during the holiday at an extra cost. They are typically trips to water parks, boat trips, kayaking etc.
- **20. Can I pay by cheque?** If you have a euro account, you can pay by cheque in euros.
- **21. What is the easiest and cheapest way to pay in Euros?** Most people pay by bank transfer. We also have partner foreign exchange companies you can use to make the payment to us, which guarantee better rates than the banks.
- 22. Can I pay by credit card? Yes this is possible.
- **23.** Do gentleman have to wear long trousers for dinner? The hotels expect men to wear trousers in the dining room at dinner time.
- **24.** Do you organize flights? No, we are not a flight agency so we do not book flights.

- **25.** How many airports are there in Majorca? Only one, Palma Majorca airport (Son Sant Joan, PMI).
- **26.** What day should I arrive and depart? There is no training on the arrival (first) day nor the departure (last) day. If you are staying for just one holiday these are the best days to arrive and leave. We typically have an arrival meeting on the evening of the arrival day.
- 27. Is it possible to stay extra nights or two or more holidays? Yes it is possible to stay extra nights (please see the extra night prices on the specific holiday price information). It is also possible to stay more than one holiday and each subsequent holiday will receive a discount (please see prices).
- **28.** Is there training on the arrival and departure days? There are no sessions planned for those days, however if there is space in the pool triathlets on the holiday are welcome to use the pool but without a coach.
- 29. Is it possible to join a holiday after the start date or cross between holidays? Although not ideal, it is possible.

FTH BOOKING CONDITIONS

The receipt of your deposit is considered acceptance of the following standard booking conditions, which are set out by the Association of British Travel Agents and recommended in the Guidelines for Tour Operators.

BEST CENTRE SPORT AND TRAVEL S.L. Terms & Conditions of Booking

All bookings are made with Best Centre Sport And Travel S.L. The payment of the deposit will be taken as you and your party's acceptance of the following conditions. The expression "client" may be used in these conditions not only to apply to you but to all other members of your party on whose behalf you have booked. Reading the booking conditions and information form part of your contract with us.

- Booking Provisional bookings should be made by email or telephone to ensure that the training facilities, accommodation and transport, if needed, are available on the dates required. After receipt of your deposit a binding contract comes into effect between you, the client, and us.
- Payment of the balance The balance of the cost of the training camp must be paid at least 8 weeks before departure. If the balance is not paid in time we reserve the right to cancel your camp, retain the deposit and apply the cancellation charges set out below. For bookings made within 8 weeks of departure, you will be required to pay the full cost of the camp at the time of booking.
- 3. Changes by you In the event of your wishing to change the details of a confirmed booking, you will be charged an amendment, if any, in the cost of the revised arrangements. Where a change is made within 8 weeks of departure we will treat such changes as a cancellation of the original booking. Any costs incurred by us will be passed on and may be as high as 100% of the cost of the holiday. All amendments must be in writing. No refund will be made for unused accommodation or services due to voluntary variation of a holiday
- 4. Cancellation by you You, or any member of your party, may cancel your holiday at any time providing that the cancellation is made by the person making the booking, and is communicated to us in writing. If this incurs administrative costs we shall retain the deposit of the client that cancelled and in addition may apply cancellation charges of the remaining balance up to the maximum below.Period before departure and cancellation charges shown as a cancellation is the percentage of the remaining blalance of the holiday price:56 days or more Deposit only 55-29 Days 20% 28-8 Days 75% 7- 4 Days 90% 3 days or less to departure 100% If cancellation is caused by illness or certain unavoidable causes, your own insurance policy may apply.
- 5. Travel Insurance It is a requirement, when booking your camp, that you hold a policy to cover the group. In the event of an emergency, should you not have adequate insurance cover, although we will offer all reasonable assistance, it must be understood that you will be responsible for any costs involved as a result of your failure to take out adequate cover. Please read your policy details carefully. It is your responsibility to ensure that the insurance cover you purchase is adequate for the particular needs of you and your party. We do not check alternative insurance policies.
- 6. Alteration by us We plan your camp arrangements many months in advance and although it is unlikely that we shall have to make any changes to confirmed arrangements, it does occasionally happen. Most changes are of a minor nature and we will advise you at the earliest possible date. If a major change occurs, we shall inform you as soon as is reasonably possible. A major change is where we offer you accommodation of a lower standard, or training facilities that are not available. In such cases you have

the choice of either accepting the revised arrangements as notified to you, or cancelling your camp with full refund of money paid. For all these alternatives we will pay compensation on the scale shown below (plus full refund of all money paid if you choose to cancel). We will not cancel your camp within 8 weeks of departure unless caused by events beyond our control or failure on your part to pay the final balance. In circumstances where we are unable to provide the camp booked, we will offer to you an alternative camp of comparable standard of, if this is unacceptable, we will return to you all monies paid.
- 8. Our responsibility for your camp We accept responsibility for ensuring that all component parts of your camp are supplied to you as confirmed by us on your conformation, and that the services offered reach a reasonable standard. If any such part is not provided, we will pay you an appropriate compensation if this has affected the enjoyment of your camp (see important note above). We have taken all reasonable and proper care to ensure that proper arrangements have been made for all our camps and that the suppliers of the various services provided to you as part of your camp are efficient, safe and reputable and comply with the local and National Law and regulation of the country in which they provide those services. However we do not have direct control over the provision of services to clients by suppliers, and we cannot be held responsible or liable for injury or death or illness caused to clients unless through negligence of our employees. We shall give every assistance we can to a client who through mishap suffers illness, personal injury or death during the period of the camp arising out of an activity which neither forms part of the camp arrangements nor forms part of an excursion offered through us, provided we are advised of the incident within 90 days of its occurrence. Nothing in condition 8 shall apply to anything arising during or out of carriage by air, sea or land and will be subject to the condition of carriage of the carrier operating these services.
- 9. Your responsibility to us It is your responsibility to ensure that you arrive in good time to board all flights or other method of transport. If you miss a flight or other transportation we will try to arrange alternative transportation, but reserve the right to recover from you any costs we incur in making such arrangements. Payment may be required from you before boarding.
- 10. Price Guarantees As per Association of British Travel Agents rules. The price of your camp is subject to surcharges only on the following items:Governmental action, currency, aircraft fuel, over flying charges, airport charges and increases in scheduled air fares. Even in this case, we will absorb an amount equivalent to 2% of the holiday price which excludes insurance premiums and amendment charges. If this means paying more than 10% of the holiday price, you will be entitled to cancel your holiday with a full refund. Should you decide to cancel because of this, you must exercise your right to do so within 14 days from the issue date printed on the invoice. In return for this guarantee there will be no refund in the event of favourable costs or currency movements. We reserve the right to revise prices for new bookings in the event of any change.

If you do not follow this simple procedure it may affect your right to claim against us. Disputes arising out of, or in connection with this contract, which cannot be amicable settled may (if the customer so wishes) be referred to arbitration under a Special Scheme which, though devised by arrangement with the Association of British Travel Agents, is administered quite independently by the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. The Scheme (details of which will be supplied by ABTA on request) provides for a simple and inexpensive method of arbitration on documents alone with restricted liability on the customer in the event of costs.
